I, like all of you, am concerned about the state economy. I want each of you to know we at the city planned for this downturn. When we put together the 2008-2009 budget for the city, we positioned ourselves to deal with these issues. We did not hire additional employees or purchase equipment, with the exception of public safety vehicles. I have implemented a procedure we call "position evaluation review", making sure that the employees we have meet our needs to provide professional quality public services. When vacancies occur we carefully evaluate each one. If the work can be done at the same level without filling

the position, we eliminate the position. We have eliminated 2 part time positions in this budget year already. Our department heads share my policies of sound fiscal management. They do a great job in managing their budgets.

No one knows what the effects of the current down turn in the economy short term or long term will be. I wanted to let each of you know we have done, and will continue to do, our part to maintain the current level of services, and that we'll manage your tax investment wisely. We will live within our means just like each of you do. I am very optimistic that our city will come through

this in much better condition than most because of our planning.

I am also very excited to see the wonderful new businesses that are just about completed in our downtown. Each new business will help by creating new jobs and providing sales tax revenues, as well as revitalizing our historic Main Street. Our hard work has paid wonderful dividends.

I sincerely want to thank you again for the opportunity to be Mayor in this very special city. I pledge to you my continued hard work to meet the challenges ahead.
