MESSAGE FROM THE MAYOR

In my mind something very special took place on Wednesday March 16. On that day City Councils from Tooele City, Grantsville City and Stockton passed Resolutions settling the long protracted, expensive, ongoing lawsuit between the Cities. We agreed to an idea made by the Grantsville City Council and Mayor Marshall, that if Tooele City assists them in building a new Library, they would drop their suit against us. The members of our council and I, after discussing the idea, unanimously agreed. Why did we agree at this time you might ask? The answer is quite simple instead of

large unacceptable sums of money as had previously been asked for, it allowed us to make something very positive out of what has long been a very contentious situation. Money from the Depot Redevelopment Project Area will be used to help pay for a wonderful addition to the community and the citizens of Grantsville. I applaud Mayor Marshall and the members of the Grantsville City Council for their willingness to seriously negotiate with us on the suit, at the same time having the vision of the needs of their city. I applaud the members of our council who agreed to accept their idea and carry it through. We are thrilled to

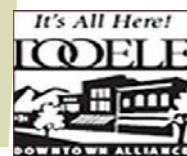

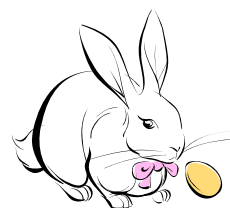

If the salesman doesn't have the badge, contact either the Recorder's Office (if during the day) at (435) 843-2110 or dispatch at 882-5600. A police officer will respond to your area. If you are a salesman and want to go door-to-door in Tooele City, get your itinerant/transient merchant license at the Tooele City Recorder's Office.

Business Licenses: All business licenses should have been paid for 2011. If not, the license has been placed in an "inactive" or "closed" status. If you are needing to renew your business license, all fees accrued must be paid. Contact the Recorder's Office for more information at 435-843-2110, or lisac@tooelecity.org.

Anyone offering a service from their home for compensation requires a Tooele City business license. This includes contracts, even if licensed by the State. You can access the Business License application at www.tooelecity.org.

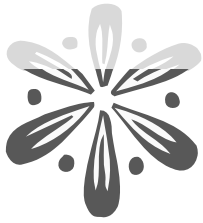
