Those who have not paid their Business License Renewal fee: A 50% LATE FEE will be implemented on February 1, 2013. You will have until March 1, 2013 to pay the licensing fee + the penalty fee. If we have not heard from you, your license will be considered "inactive" and we will CLOSE your business after March 15, 2013. You can mail in your payment, drop your payment off in the Finance Department at City Hall OR drop off your payment in the utility payment drop box to the south of City Hall. If you are no longer in business, please let us know in writing by e-mailing lisac@tooelecity.org or fax (435) 843-2119 and we will close your license. If you have questions, please contact the Records Office at (435) 843-2110.

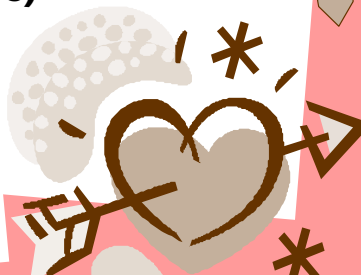

Answers....

1. James Madison, the 4th President, was called "The Father of the Constitution". He was one of two Presidents to sign the Constitution. (George Washington was the other).
2. Franklin D. Roosevelt, the 32nd President, was elected to four consecutive terms, and served slightly more than 12 years, before dying in office.
3. Only one month after being elected, William Harrison (the 9th President) died in office due to illness.
4. Abraham Lincoln (16th), James A. Garfield (20th), William McKinley (25th) and John F. Kennedy (35th).
5. In 1939, Franklin D. Roosevelt was the first president to appear on television.
