\$2,000.00 per year

With your adoption, you receive a blank slate white buffalo (8'x5'). We will collaborate with you on an artist, location, design, and paint. You will receive a small plaque with your name to be placed with the buffalo. We will take care of installation.

You've likely seen Park City and their moose, Ogden and their horses, or St. George and their buffalo. These works of art attract people to come to your town. They become "Insta-Famous", and not only do people see the businesses that care about their town, but the money stays in our downtown to revitalize it.
