Keep Your Pipes Open To Avoid Freezing

Every year when the weather turns cold the City sees a rash of reports of frozen pipes. The best thing that you can do to prevent this in your home is to keep the pipes open. Leaving a slow drip or trickle in a faucet overnight, when the temperature and water usage is lowest, can prevent the water in your pipes from sitting still and freezing. As the weather gets colder over a longer stretch of time, the ground freezes deeper and deeper and puts more homes at risk of frozen pipes every day. Yes, the slow drip or trickle may end up costing you a little extra on your water bill, but that amount will always be dramatically less than the cost to repair frozen pipes in your home and the water damage it can cause. Residents are encouraged to dispose of their Christmas trees by placing them at the curbside on their bulky waste pick-up day. In addition to Christmas trees, other acceptable items include: old appliances, furniture, carpet, couches and mattresses. All smaller items must be bagged, boxed or bundled. Bundles must be less than 5 ft. long, under 18" in diameter and less than 75 lbs., tied with twine.

For Tooele City Residents: If your trash container is broken or in need of repair, contact Tooele City at (435) 843-2150. If the damage is from normal wear and tear, the repairs or replacement will be made free of charge.

Please Help Us Serve You Better By Doing The Following:

- Put your cans out by 6:30 a.m.
- Place cans 3 feet apart
- Do not overload cans
- Do not place cans directly against the curb (when the cans are being set down, if they hit the curb it damages the wheels).
- Promptly pull in your cans after they have been dumped—this helps our snowplow drivers to remove snow more efficiently from your street.
- On windy days, please take care to ensure there is no loose garbage on the top that may blow out and litter the streets.

We appreciate your efforts to help us maintain a safe, clean and beautiful city!



City ordinance prohibits parking on city streets between the hours of 2 a.m. to 6 a.m. from November 1st through March 31st. Please help city snowplow drivers by not parking on the streets and keeping things like basketball hoops off the streets! Thanks!

ATTENTION BUSINESS OWNERS:

Those who have not paid their Business License Renewal fee: A 50% LATE FEE will be implemented on February 1, 2017. You will have until March 1, 2017 to pay the licensing fee + the penalty fee. If we have not heard from you, your license will be considered "inactive" and we will CLOSE your business after March 15, 2017. You can mail in your payment, drop your payment off in the Finance Department at City Hall OR in the drop box to the south of City Hall. If you are no longer in business, please let us know in writing, by e-mailing lisac@tooelecity.org and we will be happy to close your license. ALL door-to-door salesmen (Itinerant/Transient Merchants) must be licensed with Tooele City and must have a 2017 PURPLE Tooele City ID Badge on and in plain sight. Animal Licenses

It is now Animal License Renewal time for 2017. Please renew your license by February 28th or your license fee will double as of March 1st.

All dogs and cats within Tooele City limits and over the age of four months must be licensed each year. The license renewal application must be accompanied by a current rabies vaccination certificate. License renewal fees may be paid at Tooele City Hall (90 North Main Street, Tooele) in the Finance Department. If you have any questions, please contact the Finance Department at (435) 843-2150.

Renewal Fees:

Female/Male Dog - \$20.00

Neutered or spayed dog - \$10.00

(Must indicate on Rabies Certificate animal is neutered or spayed or have supporting documentation.)

Female/Male Cat - 10.00

Spayed or Neutered Cat - \$5.00 (Must indicate on Rabies Certificate animal is neutered or spayed or have supporting documentation).

Dear Tooele City Residents,

Tooele City has entered into negotiations with Ace Disposal to provide our citizens with a bi-weekly curbside recycling program. Citizens will be delivered a blue recycling receptacle which will allow for plastics, metal, paper products and cardboard to be recycled. These items will need to be empty but will not have to be rinsed, cleaned or sorted prior to placing them in the recycling receptacle. Green waste and glass will not be recycled. The cost of this service will be approximately \$4.75 to \$6.00 per month. The pick-up of the recycling receptacle will be every other week on the same day as your waste service.

The opt-in period will be from January 1, 2017 through January 31, 2017. ACE Disposal will begin delivering recycling receptacles during January 2017 and the projected start date for this service is February 2017. A pick-up schedule and a list of items that may be put in your recycling receptacle will be provided with delivery of your receptacle. A pick-up schedule and a list of acceptable and unacceptable items will also be available on our website, www.tooelecity.org. Once service begins, citizens will only be allowed to opt-out on an annual basis.

If you choose to opt-in, please return the bottom portion of this letter by mail or in person to the Finance Department at Tooele City Hall located at 90 North Main Street, Tooele, UT 84074. You may also submit this form by fax at (435) 843-2159. An online form may be submitted on our website at www.tooelecity.org.
