All cemetery monuments or markers must be placed in compliance with the specifications of the Tooele City Cemetery Ordinance and policies. Before a monument or marker is placed, the Tooele City Cemetery Office must be notified and the fee paid. All markers and monuments require a permit be obtained by the Monument Company as well as an inspection performed by the Cemetery Supervisor or designee prior to placement. All monuments and markers will be inspected at the Cemetery prior to being taken off of the truck for installation. The inspection will be performed by the Cemetery Supervisor or their designee. The inspection process may include but will not be limited to the following criteria: overall dimensions for the specified lot or lots; height, width and depth; material; size of lawnmower strip, flower vases; etc. All monuments or markers shall be of granite, marble or memorial bronze. Monuments or markers shall be set in a concrete foundation which is 4" thick with a concrete lawnmower strip not less than 4" extending beyond the stone or vase. Upright monuments or markers shall not exceed 36" in height. Flat monuments or markers shall not exceed 3" in height. Only one monument or marker will be permitted at the head of the grave space. Up to four secondary markers will be permitted on any one grave space. The monument or marker may be a single stone designating a single burial site, a double designating two burial sites, or a combined marker designating no more than three burial sites. The length of the monument or marker, to include the concrete lawnmower strip, shall not exceed 42" for a single or 90" for a double/triple. A twenty-four hour notice is required prior to setting a monument or marker. Monuments or markers may not be set on Saturdays, Sundays, legal observed holidays or 2 days before and after Memorial Day.
